The **Tree Kangaroo Conservation Program (TKCP)** is a Papua New Guinea based and registered non-profit organization which has worked with the communities and landowners in the Yopno-Uruwa-Som (YUS) landscape since 1996. Together with YUS landowners and the PNG Government, TKCP helped to establish the country's first nationally-protected Conservation Area in 2009.

Applications are invited for this management role based in Lae.

SPONSORSHIP, MARKETING AND COMMUNICATIONS MANAGER

The role will be responsible for developing partnerships and securing sponsorships and funding to support TKCP's ongoing conservation efforts and community support initiatives within the YUS Conservation Area.

Key Responsibilities:

- Engage with businesses, sponsors, and potential donors to secure funding, and organize flagship fundraising events annually to support TKCP's operational costs
- Develop and implement communication strategies to boost TKCP's visibility, strengthen community relations, and foster engagement with key stakeholders and the broader public
- Secure sponsorships and donations from businesses and other donors, organizing successful events such as an annual golf day and supporters' breakfast to generate financial support
- Execute a communications strategy that enhances TKCP's presence in mainstream media, editorials, and publications
- Manage and grow TKCP's social media presence and website to build engagement, broaden the supporter base, and increase the organization's outreach and impact.

- Bachelor's degree or higher qualifications in Communications, Marketing, Public Relations, or a related field
- Valid PNG driver's license (minimum Class 3)
- Experience in partnership development, fundraising, and communications, ideally in the non-profit or NGO sector

- Strong organizational skills with the ability to manage multiple projects and meet deadlines


