Key Responsibilities:

- Install safety and distribution components (switches, resistors, circuit breaker panels etc...)
- Carry out preventive inspections and repair maintenance where necessary
- Perform effective troubleshooting to identify hazards or malfunctions and repair or substitute damaged units
- Provide breakdown reports and initiate improvement work plans
- Attend to CEB work plans as assigned by the Site Supervisor.
