- Undertake pilotage duties in other Ports as and when required
- Provide training for new and up and coming marine pilots
- Continuously review existing emergency procedures and incident reporting and provide advice and recommendation on areas that require improvement
- Submit periodic reports to the Chief Pilot for management's attention.

- Standard Training Certification for Watch-keeping (International requirement)
