Papua New Guinea **National Maritime Safety Authority (NMSA)** was Established by the NMSA Act 2003 and is responsible for promoting, complying with and maintaining world class maritime safety standards in Papua New Guinea consistent with legislation and commitments under National Legislation and International Conventions in order to facilitate a safe, efficient and environmentally responsible shipping sector for stakeholders in government, industry and the community.

Under the mandate, NMSA ensures a fully functioning and effective network of aids to navigation; availability of high quality and up to date navigational charts; that vessels meet the safety standards required by law and international commitments; ensuring seafarers' competency through vigilant examination and certification, and coordinating maritime responses to distress calls and monitoring and controlling ship-sourced pollution.

Reporting to the Manager Ship Survey & Inspection, the role is responsible to oversee and coordinate internal and external surveyors and the activities of ship inspections and assisting in monitoring and conducting seafarers' examinations.

Key Responsibilities:

- Contribute to the development and ensure monitoring of the annual survey programs
- Ensure effective leadership, mentoring and timely guidance is provided to all field officers
- Ensure all inspections and surveys meet requirements prior to issuing statutory certificates
- Maintain dialogue and relationship with all internal and external stakeholders
- Ensure periodical operations reports and management reports are accurate and submitted on a timely basis
- Plan and conduct in liaison with Qualification department to ensure all oral examinations meet Standard of Training, Certification and Watch-keeping for seafarers (STCW)
- Ensure requirements for carriage of dangerous goods are complied with and in accordance with Merchant Shipping Dangerous Goods Act (MSDG Act)
- Assist in marine casualty investigations as and when required and provide reports
- Identify unsafe shipping and take preventative measures through periodical circulars and notices being sent out to the shipping industry.

Expected Competencies:

- Master Class 1 / Engineer Class 1
- Minimum of 5 years' experience either as a surveyor, ships inspector, shipyard manager, technical manager in a shipping company and as a Designated Person Ashore
- Applied knowledge of:
 - FSI and PSI
 - PNG Shipping Act
 - Ship yards and or shipping administration
 - Safety standards
- Good leadership, interpersonal, communication and analytical skills
- Advance computer, good report writing skills and ability to mentor, coordinate and liaise.
