Reporting to the Senior Occupational Health & Hygiene Specialist, the Physiotherapist is responsible to provide professional physiotherapy services to Newmont employees and participate in planned Occupational health awareness outreach programs.

Key Responsibilities:

- Assess, diagnose and treat injuries that affect employees in rehabilitating physical problems caused by illness, injury, disability or aging, through treatment
- Provide a professional and high standard of Physiotherapy Advice to employees (Newmont, Business Partners)
- Provide therapeutic treatments, rehabilitation and interventions to clients presenting with musculoskeletal conditions, acute injuries and chronic aches and pains
- Assess client's physical abilities through evaluative procedures to identify and provide diagnosis
- Plan and implement programs of physiotherapy including, therapeutic exercises, joint manipulations, massage, electro-therapeutic treatments, other mechanical equipment, and hydrotherapy
- Evaluate effectiveness of treatment plans and implement modifications as required and record effectiveness
- Provide advice on exercise and strategies to enhance and/ or maintain treatment. Refer to exercises' specialist or other members of the team when needed
- Maintain accurate clinical and statistical records, notes, and always adhere to client's confidentiality requirements
- Education of clients, family members, and other relevant stakeholders onsite on how to prevent physical injuries and live a healthy lifestyle. Participate in internal quality improvement for Preventative Health Care
- Contribute to, and in some cases lead, projects and strategies that proactively aim to reduce the prevalence of musculoskeletal injury and conditions in the workplace environment
